Big success at XXIII European Backgammon Championship in the charming Velden

Shimon Kagan from Israel is the new king of backgammon in Europe. The new European champion F.2 is Arda Findikoglu from Turkey and the



It was a perfect celebration of 10 years of Backgammon in Velden, with some of the most famous players participating at the Velden Backgammon Open. Shimon Kagan won the 10.000 euros (including an added 1.600 euros) and the Super-Jackpot. The new European Champions in the Doubles Consulting Championship are David Boldini from Switzerland and Hormoz Shahrokhshahi from Iran. 97 players from 23 countries, took part in the 7 events. They played for 5 days and shared a total money distribution of 49.990 euros, including an additional 1.600 euros for the winner.

Happiness and competition were the characteristics of the latest XXIII European Backgammon Championship, which celebrated 10 years in the charming Velden, right in the heart of the Europe.

The European Champion 2011 is Shimon Kagan from Israel, who also won the Super-jackpot and was finalist in the Warm-up. Shimon is a very good player and he arrived at the top winning against Florin Pocora from Romania (13 to 4), Kimon Papachristopoulos from Greece/Germany (13 to 12), the British John Broomfield (15 to 4), the German Mario Kühl (17 to 15) and against Alexandru Papadumitru from Romania (19 to 4). In the Master category there was glory also for Costas Chiotinis from Greece, who won the Consolation against Sabri Büyüksoy from Turkey (17 to 3) and for the Austrian Helmut Gerdenits, who won the Last Chance against Hormoz Shahrokhshahi from

Iran/Germany (7 to 6). In the Doubles Consulting, 25 teams fought for the title of the Doubles European Champions and the 7.500 euros of prize money, with a total money distribution in this tournament of 12.500 euros. The Champions are the Swiss David Boldini in partnership with the Persian/German Hormoz Shahrokhshahi. In the first round they took a late arrival, then they won against the Greeks Deliakis/Vallianos (9 to 6), the Croatian Jurlin/Kovacic (9 to 2), the Austrian Lukas/Urbantschitsch (9 to 6) and finally the Italian/Austrian team Azizian/Parlow (11 to 10). Croatian Mislav Kovacic (11 to 9), the Swiss David Boldini (13 to 0), the Turkish Mehmet Güven (15 to 5) and the Czech Pavel Zaoral (17 to 16) in an incredible final game. The German Günther Holzinger won the Consolation against the Italian Andrea Sirch (15 to 11) and the Czech Honza Cerny won the last chance against the Austrian Thomas Leitner (5 to 3). In the Intermediate, the new European Champion is the lovely Seda Koc from Turkey, girlfriend of Arda Findikoglu and perfect assistant in every Turkish competition. She won the European title defeating the Italian Maria Croce (7 to 0), the Romanian/Italian Viorel Popa (7 to 6), the Slovakian Maria Kaceriakova (10 to 7), the Chinese Kwok Yan Ip (9 to 6) and in the last match the Egyptian/Austrian Mahmoud Taha (11 to 10). In the Super-Jackpot, as written above, Shimon Kagan won against Kimon Papachristopoulos (11 to 10). against the Turkish Seda Koc (her again!).
